Value: Two scholarships awarded \$3,750 per recipient (\$1,250 per year, applicable to first-year students only)

Established in 1983 as a supporting organization to the GSB, the Herbert V. Prochnow Educational Foundation supports research in banking education, and sponsors a number of educational programs and activities. Each year the Foundation awards scholarships for the three-year Graduate School of Banking program through the Indiana Bankers Association. The scholarships are based on admission requirements as determined by the IBA. Each scholarship covers one-third of the annual cost, with the institution responsible for the remaining amount.

Scholarship application deadline is March 15.
